Mural's last pieces falling into place

Artist Michael Cooper added the final stroke to his new downtown mural yesterday at a ceremony at Church Street Park.

Piecing It All Together shows three workmen — the artist and the building's two owners — putting the building facade together like a jigsaw puzzle.

Cooper, of Franklin, spent three months painting the side of the building at 206 Capitol Blvd. Cooper was commissioned to paint the mural by a committee of downtown business

owners and city officials.

Ronny Greer, who owns the building at 206 Capitol Blvd. with his business partner Dwight Work, helped put finishing touches on the mural too. Their accounting and consulting firm, Work and Greer, has its offices in the building. The mural project was coordinated by the Nashville Downtown Partnership, an affiliate of the Nashville Area Chamber of Commerce that works for downtown improvement projects.
